

Proposition 84 Statewide Park Program – Round One



City of Tulare
Mulcahy Park

This project will create the new Mulcahy Park in the City of Tulare through development of 3.4 acres and construction of a multi-purpose turf field, walking trail, shaded tot lot, splash pad, two picnic areas, restrooms, landscaping, and lighting.

Through community based planning meetings, youth, seniors, and families selected these features. Additional design ideas from residents to be included in the project are:

- Sports field with better grass, walking trail, tot lot for younger children, splash pad, picnic shelters with barbecues, shade trees, park lighting for safety, restroom.
- Locate turf area on easterly two-thirds of site. Place recreation features on west side of park.
- Use lighting throughout park, include restroom for park sanitation, use Neighborhood Watch program so residents can observe park.
- Plant lots of shade trees when landscaping park.
- At least twenty Sequoia Community Corps members will construct a watering approximately 6,000 square feet of pathways, and plant approximately 150 native or drought tolerant trees and shrubs.

The project will include these sustainable techniques:


- Irrigation system with “smart” feature to limit water use.
- Use pervious surfaces and bio-swale with native and/or drought tolerant plants.
- Use recycled materials in play structures, surfacing beneath play structures, benches, and in trash and recycling containers in park.
- Use grass suitable for Tulare’s climate, climate-appropriate trees, and drought-tolerant shrubs.
- Project may use solar park lighting. If not used, project will use “smart” controller for lights and restroom locks, skylights in restrooms to reduce lighting needs, and movement sensors to turn lights on and off.
- Use low flow toilets, mulch in shrub beds, and splash pad “push-on” feature to reduce water use.

The park will be open weekdays from 6 AM – 8 AM & 3 PM –10 PM, and on weekends, from 6 AM – 10 PM. No entrance or membership fees will be charged.
