SUBJECT: Update

Summary

Representatives from the United States Forest Service (Forest), California State Parks, and the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Commission formed a working group to discuss issues and concerns that affect Pacific Crest Trail use. The goal of the meeting was to understand PCT management and develop an effective communication strategy between agencies and organizations. The group will hold additional meetings with stakeholders and other agencies.

Discussion

The working group met on September 26, 2018 at Folsom State Recreation Area. Discussion topics included PCT management and administration responsibilities; recreational programs and uses including over snow areas/over snow trails, and federal and state plans, regulations, and land management practices; and desired outcomes for trail users and land managers. Additional agencies and stakeholders will be invited to participate in future meetings.
