Comments submitted by the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Division to individual grant applicants should in no way be construed as a guarantee of successful results for the applicant within the competitive grants process or a commitment of funding. Additionally, the lack of comments by the OHMVR Division to any specific applicant does not ensure successful results for the applicant within the competitive grant process or a commitment of funding.

All final applications will be reviewed by the OHMVR Division. The OHMVR Division may, at its sole discretion, decrease the requested amount and eliminate activities pursuant with regulation Section 4970.07.2 (f)(1-5) and for law enforcement projects, regulation Section 4970.15.3(b)(1-5).

Failure by applicant to respond to any OHMVR Division comment of their preliminary application shall be cause for eliminating that item from the applicant's application.

If multiple proposed projects are requesting funding for the same deliverable, and multiple projects are successful, only one project will receive funding for the deliverable.

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for snow and/or winter activities. Applicants must ensure the activities and/or equipment requested are not and/or cannot be funded by the OHMVR Division Winter Program (commonly referred to as the Snow Grooming Program).

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for the maintenance of roads and/or trails, note that only roads and/or trails that allow "green sticker" off-highway vehicles are allowed to receive grant funding.

Applicants are reminded that no grant funds and/or match can be expended or project activities conducted in any land owned or managed by the California Department of Parks and Recreation.

- #10 – Narrative does not support "At least 25%..." selection.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Staff – Outdoor Recreation Planner/Heavy Equipment Operator/Seasonal Maintenance Worker line items- Applicant must justify large increase in hours over previous year’s project.</li> <li>• Materials and Supplies – OHV Maintenance, Fuel- These line items are Equipment Use Expense category and must be moved.</li> <li>• Equipment Use Expenses – BLM Truck- Applicant must identify vehicle.</li> <li>• Others – Employee Travel is an Indirect Cost. Applicant must adjust line item accordingly.</li> <li>• Others – Vault Toilet Pumping- This is a Contract category line item, applicant must move to Contracts.</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• #2a – Applicant must list number of special status species.</li> <li>• #2b – Applicant must provide the date of the reference document.</li> <li>• #2c – Applicant must provide the name and date of the reference document, e.g. survey.</li> <li>• #3 – Applicant must provide the date of the reference document.</li> <li>• #7 – New kiosk and water efficient landscaping are not part of this Development project. Balance of project does not support selection.</li> </ul>	

- #9 – Project does not improve or create a new trail.
- #11 – Applicant must identify who “LMC” is. Providing user education is not an eligible Development activity. The Lassen Co. Sheriff’s Dept. is not an eligible partner as patrolling is not an eligible Development activity. The California Dept. of Fish and Wildlife is not an eligible partner as monitoring is not an eligible Development activity.
- #13 – Applicant must explain what offsite impacts will be addressed.
