Comments submitted by the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Division to individual grant applicants should in no way be construed as a guarantee of successful results for the applicant within the competitive grants process or a commitment of funding. Additionally, the lack of comments by the OHMVR Division to any specific applicant does not ensure successful results for the applicant within the competitive grant process or a commitment of funding.

All final applications will be reviewed by the OHMVR Division. The OHMVR Division may, at its sole discretion, decrease the requested amount and eliminate activities pursuant with regulation Section 4970.07.2 (f)(1-5) and for law enforcement projects, regulation Section 4970.15.3(b)(1-5).

Failure by applicant to respond to any OHMVR Division comment of their preliminary application shall be cause for eliminating that item from the applicant’s application.

If multiple proposed projects are requesting funding for the same deliverable, and multiple projects are successful, only one project will receive funding for the deliverable.

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for snow and/or winter activities. Applicants must ensure the activities and/or equipment requested are not and/or cannot be funded by the OHMVR Division Winter Program (commonly referred to as the Snow Grooming Program).

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for the maintenance of roads and/or trails, note that only roads and/or trails that allow “green sticker” off-highway vehicles are allowed to receive grant funding.

Applicants are reminded that no grant funds and/or match can be expended or project activities conducted in any land owned or managed by the California Department of Parks and Recreation.

General Evaluation Criteria

- #11a – Narrative does not support selection. It is unclear if free literature is provided to visitors describing information on safe and responsible OHV use.
- #12b – Information was not found on applicant’s website to support “Safety information” or “Information on responsible riding” OHV related selections.

Project Cost Estimate

- Staff – OHV Project Coordinator – Applicant must provide a breakdown of duties of the position to justify three years of full time equivalent position.
- Staff – Management and Admin Staff/Tribal Administrator, Resource Staff/Accounting Clerk, Tribal Council – These line items appear to be Indirect Costs. Applicant must provide additional details.
- Staff – Cultural Resource Monitor – Duties related to completion of necessary grant requirements are an Indirect Cost.
- Contracts – Environmental Consultant – Cost appears excessive. Applicant must provide additional details on what comprises this contract.
- Equipment Use Expenses – Field Vehicle, Fuel, Vehicle Maintenance – Applicant must provide additional information on how these line items are related to a Planning project. Applicant must also provide a breakdown of the cost in quantity and rate.
- Equipment Purchases – Laptop – Applicant must provide additional details.
- Others – Travel – Applicant must provide additional information regarding this line item to justify how it is related to a Planning project.

Evaluation Criteria

- #2b – Narrative does not support any selections and does not provide a detailed explanation for each statement checked.
- #3 – A planning project for an OHV Park only does not support selections.
- #4 – Publicly Noticed Meetings – Narrative does not support the response.
- #5 – Narrative does not provide a detailed explanation of how each stakeholder will provide substantial input in this planning project.
- #6 – Narrative only supports Bureau of Indian Affairs selection related to this planning project.
- #7 – Narrative does not support “Project supports development of OHV opportunities in areas that lack legal OHV Opportunity” selection.
