6. Jurisdiction:

The USFS Cleveland National Forest Patrol District is broken down into three Ranger Districts.

Descanso (based in Alpine), Corral Canyon/Bear Valley consists of 1800 acres, 28 miles of designated OHV trails and 28 miles of maintenance level 2 roads which are also open for OHV and street legal vehicles.. The area is supported by 2 staging areas and 2 campgrounds. In addition to the designated OHV routes there are approximately 128 miles of Level 2 roads which are open to street legal OHV vehicles throughout the Cleveland National Forest.

Trabuco (based in Corona), Wildomar OHV Area is the only legal off road area available in western Riverside and Orange Counties. The site is located approximately 9 miles south of the junction of Ortega Highway (State Hwy 74) and South Main Divide Road. Wildomar OHV Area consists of, and requires enforcement patrols for, 360 acres and approximately 8 miles of trails for off-road motorcycles, ATV's and 4WD vehicles. In addition to the designated OHV areas there are approximately 105 miles of Level 2 roads which are open to street legal OHV vehicles throughout the Trabuco Ranger District.

Palomar (based in Ramona) Palomar District enforcement is primarily trespass enforcement. No legal OHV areas.
