Some of this funding should be considered for reallocation to purchase equipment such as an ROV, radios, and game cameras.

**Additional Notes:**

Because of low LE staff levels the BLM Ukiah Field Office does not have the bodies it needs to fill additional shift coverage on South Cow Mountain, Walker Ridge, and Knoxville Recreation Area. There are 4 LE positions at the BLM Ukiah Field office and currently only one is filled. The OHV storage container for Cow Mountain has been ordered but not yet acquired and installed on site. Currently only one of the patrol trucks has a Dual Band APX 7500 Motorola radio; this is the radio base unit necessary for communications with local agencies. Three more of these radios are needed to outfit the other patrol vehicles for when LE positions are filled. The new grant funded MTV LE computer is mounted in one of the patrol vehicle, as is the new LED emergency lights. The BLM Ukiah Field Office could also use an additional UTV OHV patrol vehicle for saturation patrols and special event coverage.
