6. Jurisdiction:

USFS Stanislaus contains property within Alpine County, Calaveras County, Mariposa County and Tuolumne County.

The project area encompasses 539,885 acres of National Forest System Land available for OHV road and trail opportunities out of the 898,000 total acres within the Stanislaus National Forest boundaries. OHV opportunities are available on a system of National Forest Transportation System (NFTS) designated routes including 1,397 miles of high clearance roads open to non-highway licensed off-highway vehicles, 129 miles of trail open to all vehicles, 39 miles of high clearance four-wheel drive vehicle trails, 58 miles of ATV trails, and 70 miles of motorcycle trails. An additional 756 miles of roads are available to highway licensed vehicles (street-legal).

Over Snow Vehicle (OSV) opportunities include 3 Sno-Parks, 73 miles of signed groomed routes, 44 miles of unsigned groomed routes, 555 miles of unsigned un-groomed routes, and 181,430 acres available for cross-country OSV travel by snowmobiles.
