**6. Jurisdiction:**

The Tahoe National Forest (TNF) encompasses approximately 838,777 acres. The vast majority of the NFS land is open to land-based motorized travel on designated routes only. The TNF manages and patrols the following OHV/OSV opportunities:

175 miles of jeep routes, 40 miles of ATV Routes, 209 miles of motorcycle routes, 1508 miles of low standard roads open to non-street legal OHVs, approximately 500 miles of higher standard roads, of which 115 miles are open to non-street legal OHVs during hunting season, 27 acres of OHV open area, 14 OHV staging areas. 240 miles of groomed OSV trails, over 800 miles of un-groomed roads, which are open to OSV travel, approximately 430,000 acres in the snow zone that is open to unrestricted snowmobile use, including, Burlington, Rattlesnake, Pierce, Downieville/Sierra City trails, Gold Valley, Prosser Pits, Boca/Stampede/Prosser Reservoir, Barker Pass, Rubicon Jeep Trail, Bear Valley, Jackson Meadows, Fordyce Jeep Trail, Meadow Lake, Pierce, Sugar Pine, Foresthill Divide, Onion Valley, & Texas Hill.
