



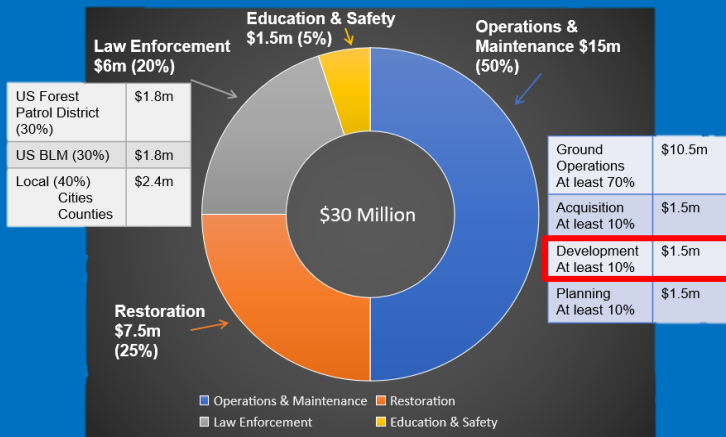

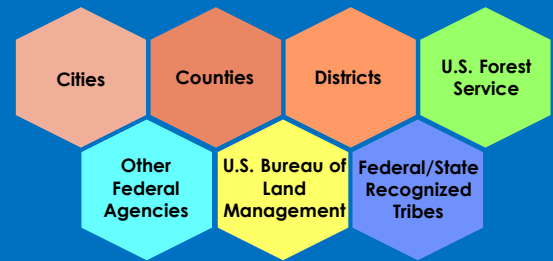
Development Fact Sheet

The Purpose: Construction of, or improvements to, Facilities to sustain or enhance OHV Recreational Opportunity and experiences.

2023 Anticipated Funding & Category Breakdown



Eligible Applicants



Development Deliverables:

- Trail & trailhead/staging area construction
- Access road, parking lot construction, and/or the removal/replacement of pavement or a parking lot
- Picnic, restrooms, kiosks, and camping facilities construction
- Infrastructure for OHV related Facilities such as electricity, water, sewage treatment
- Conservation practices regarding environmental protection
- Discretionary rerouting of roads or trails

Note: Examples are not limited to the list provided

Project Specific Information:

- Minimum request: \$10,000
- Maximum request per Applicant: \$1,000,000
- Project Length: 1 – 3 years
- 25% minimum match
- Funds can only be used where California Vehicle Code 16.5 applies
- The Applicant shall warrant that the Facility will be used for OHV Recreation*
