Project Description

- The Grants Program Safety project category is intended for applicants that serve the OHV recreating public as a whole in support of OHV Recreation and is not intended to support organized motorcycle racing event venues. As stated, applicant primarily deploys to organized District 37 race events, and 6-10 weekends (11.5% - 19.2% of the time) to non-race events. Applicant must provide additional information on specific non-race events applicant deploys to.

Project Cost Estimate

- Staff – 7,500 hours for “Other-Member hours” appears excessive considering primary deployment is to weekend race events. Provide more information.
- Materials / Supplies – Breakout costs/itemize (i.e., quantity and rate) for each item listed within “Emergency Medical Supplies”, “Safety Equipment”, and “Other-Electronics equipment”.
- Equipment Purchases – All line items appear excessive. Provide additional justification on how they are directly related to providing services to the OHV recreating public as a whole. Also, several equipment items listed were requested in previous year’s request. Provide additional information for the need of the same equipment.
- Others – Breakdown costs/itemize (i.e., quantity and rate) for “Training”. “SAR City seminar” and “Fire Dept Instructors Conference” do not appear to be essential to the project.
- Others – “Other-UTV Accessories 2” belongs in the ‘Equipment Purchase’ category. Note, the maximum grant request shall not exceed an cumulative Equipment purchase total of \$30,000.
- Others – “Other-Transportation expense” appears excessive.
- Others – “Other-UTV Accessories” and “Other-UTV Accessories 2” appears excessive.

Evaluation Criteria

- #2 – Applicant must verify response.
- #4 – Narrative does not support response. “BLM Ridgecrest” and “BLM Barstow” are not direct participants in the project.
- #6 – Narrative does not support checked items “Publicly noticed meeting(s)...” and “Meeting(s) with stakeholders”. Not clear if meeting was publicly noticed. Also, need to identify stakeholders.
- #14 – “Other [medical skills/certs]” is already addressed in item #12.
