As you know, BRC supports the decommissioning of unneeded roads, roads/routes that are causing a non-correctable severe environmental impact, and illegal ghost routes that are occurring on lands congressionally designated as Wilderness (closed to OHVs) and/or lands/routes closed to OHVs by a site-specific project-level NEPA process.

BRC believes your restoration grant lives up the spirit and intent of SB742 by restoring lands impacted by illegal OHV use.
