Additionally, the lack of comments by the OHMVR Division to any specific applicant does not ensure successful results for the applicant within the competitive grant process or a commitment of funding.

All final applications will be reviewed by the OHMVR Division. The OHMVR Division may, at its sole discretion, decrease the requested amount and eliminate activities pursuant with regulation Section 4970.07.2 (f)(1-5) and for law enforcement projects, regulation Section 4970.15.3(b)(1-5).

Failure by applicant to respond to any OHMVR Division comment of their preliminary application shall be cause for eliminating that item from the applicant's application.

Please note: If multiple proposed projects are requesting funding for the same deliverable, and multiple projects are successful, only one project will receive funding for the deliverable.

General Evaluation Criteria

- #1a –The dates do not match the dates on the land manager's application.
- #2 – Applicant to verify response.
- #5 – Applicant to verify response.
- #9 – Applicant to verify response.
- #14 – The narrative does not support "Has created a special fund to set aside funding to sustain OHV Recreation".

Project Description

- C – Applicant should clarify actual size of the project. The project size is not the entire acreage of the combined wilderness areas.
- H – Applicant must identify Soil Control Efforts relative to the project.

Project Cost Estimate

- Staff – Other-OHV Project Management and Development – Multiple items identified are Indirect Costs. Need to revise accordingly. Additionally, the quantity and rate is excessive.
- Materials/Supplies – Other-Tools – Cost appears excessive.
- Materials/Supplies – Other-Gas/Oil – Cost appears excessive and should be moved to the Equipment Use Expenses category.
- Other – Other-Background Checks – This is an Indirect Cost.

- Other – Other-Postage – This is an Indirect Cost.
- Other – Other-Outreach Supplies - This is an Indirect Cost.

Evaluation Criteria

- #2 – Narrative does not support “Threatened and endangered species” and “Other special-status species”. Only two T&E species are described in narrative.
- #5 – Applicant needs to supply date for identified plans.
- #6 – Narrative does not support response. Response needs to correspond with the land manager.
- #7 – Applicant needs to identify interested parties and provide specific date(s) for meetings.
- #8 – Need to identify how each partner will participate in the project.
- #10 – Narrative does not support response.
