Comments submitted by the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Division to individual grant applicants should in no way be construed as a guarantee of successful results for the applicant within the competitive grants process or a commitment of funding. Additionally, the lack of comments by the OHMVR Division to any specific applicant does not ensure successful results for the applicant within the competitive grant process or a commitment of funding.

All final applications will be reviewed by the OHMVR Division. The OHMVR Division may, at its sole discretion, decrease the requested amount and eliminate activities pursuant with regulation Section 4970.07.2 (f)(1-5) and for law enforcement projects, regulation Section 4970.15.3(b)(1-5).

Failure by applicant to respond to any OHMVR Division comment of their preliminary application shall be cause for eliminating that item from the applicant's application.

If multiple proposed projects are requesting funding for the same deliverable, and multiple projects are successful, only one project will receive funding for the deliverable.

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for snow and/or winter activities, Applicants must ensure the activities and/or equipment requested are not and/or cannot be funded by the OHMVR Division Winter Program (commonly referred to as the Snow Grooming Program).

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for the maintenance of roads and/or trails, note that only roads and/or trails that allow "green sticker" off-highway vehicles are allowed to receive grant funding.

Applicant must remove Law Enforcement and Restoration related activities from Project Description.</li> <li>• Applicant must clarify Part D, #2, to explain the training component and how it is related to State Parks. As a reminder, any activities related to the Division or the SVRA's is not allowed.</li> <li>• Applicant must clarify location of services. Both the Salinas River Wildlife Refuge and the San Francisco Bay National Wildlife Refuge Complex are referenced.</li> <li>• The Division suggests that the applicant change this to a Restoration project.</li> </ul>	
<b>Project Cost Estimate</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicant must provide additional details for each line item on Project Cost Estimate.</li> <li>• All Law Enforcement/Restoration line items must be removed and/or adjusted appropriately.</li> <li>• Others – Printing, Postage and Stationary Supplies appear to be indirect costs. Applicant must provide additional details.</li> </ul>	
<b>Evaluation Criteria</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• #4 – Narrative does not support response. Applicant must provide the names of each partner and detailed information regarding how each partner will participate in project.</li> <li>• #6 – Applicant must provide the following information: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Date(s) of meeting(s) and indicate if stakeholder meeting(s) is different date than publicly noticed meeting(s).</li> <li>• How the public/stakeholders meeting(s) were notified and where the meeting(s) were held.</li> <li>• Names of the stakeholders and how they are stakeholders.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• #7 – Narrative does not support any selections.</li> <li>• #8 – Narrative does not support any selections.</li> <li>• #9 – Narrative and project do not support the selection.</li> <li>• #10 – Narrative and project do not support the selection.</li> <li>• #11 – Narrative and project do not support the selection.</li> </ul>
