V. BUSINESS ITEMS ^{(1)(2a)(2c)}

- A. The Department of Motor Vehicles will brief the Commission on the *SB 742 – Off-Highway Vehicle Indicia Study Report* prepared pursuant to CVC 38165. This statute required the DMV to report to the Assembly Committee on Water, Parks and Wildlife and the Senate Committee on Natural Resources and Water, regarding recommendations to improve the identification of off-highway vehicles.
- B. The Division will brief the Commission on the California Desert Protection Act of 2010 proposed by Senator Feinstein on December 21, 2009. The bill would provide for conservation, enhanced recreation opportunities, and development of renewable energy in the Southern California Desert Conservation Area.
- C. The Commission will receive a briefing on the current status of the Clear Creek Management Area, Draft Resource Management Plan and Draft Environmental Impact Statement introduced by the BLM in November 2009.
