The OHMVR Commission tour will start from Oak Flat Campground/Staging Area at 11:00 a.m. In order to participate in this tour you must bring a high-clearance 4x4 street legal vehicle. Be advised, Oak Flat Campground/Staging Area is approximately 2 hours from the town of Hollister. No business will be conducted at this tour. This is a remote area with no commercial access to food or beverages, so please come prepared.

From the Veteran's Memorial Hall, travel south on Highway 25 for approximately 40 miles. When Highway 25 makes a sharp right turn towards King City, travel straight at the intersection on to the start of Coalinga Road. Travel approximately 16 miles to Clear Creek Road. Turn left on Clear Creek Road entering into the Clear Creek Management Area. Oak Flat Campground/Staging Area is the campground/staging area on the left hand side.
