- B – Applicant may want to indicate how the proposed project facilitates a broader regional multi-land use manager coordinated effort to sustain or manage OHV Recreation.
- C – Applicant may want to clarify the specific size of the Project Area(s).
- G – Applicant may want to address how they plan to insure the restored area(s) will be protected.

Project Cost Estimate

- Staff – “Project Manager” – this cost appears excessive. Applicant may want to provide additional information.
- Staff – “CCC Executive Director” – appears to be an Indirect Cost.
- Contracts – “Tractor Work”, “ATV Work”, and “Backhoe Work” costs appear to be duplicate costs as those listed in “Restoration Crew”. Applicant may want to provide additional information.
- Others – “Printing”, “Postage”, “TAC Review”, “Maintenance agreement”, and “Nature Preserve funding” line items appear to be an indirect cost.

Evaluation Criteria

- #2 – Narrative does not support the response with regards to “Sensitive areas...”, “Threatened and Endangered...” and “Other special-status species...”.
- #6 – Applicant may want to provide additional information regarding the reference document.
- #11 – Project description does not support the response. Applicant may want to verify the response is relative to the size of sensitive habitats which will be restored for this project.
