Comments submitted by the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Division to individual grant applicants should in no way be construed as a guarantee of successful results for the applicant within the competitive grants process or a commitment of funding. Additionally, the lack of comments by the OHMVR Division to any specific applicant does not ensure successful results for the applicant within the competitive grant process or a commitment of funding.

All final applications will be reviewed by the OHMVR Division. The OHMVR Division may, at its sole discretion, decrease the requested amount and eliminate activities pursuant with regulation Section 4970.07.2 (f)(1-5) and for law enforcement projects, regulation Section 4970.15.3(b)(1-5).

Failure by applicant to respond to any OHMVR Division comment of their preliminary application shall be cause for eliminating that item from the applicant's application.

If multiple proposed projects are requesting funding for the same deliverable, and multiple projects are successful, only one project will receive funding for the deliverable.

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for snow and/or winter activities, Applicants must ensure the activities and/or equipment requested are not and/or cannot be funded by the OHMVR Division Winter Program (commonly referred to as the Snow Grooming Program).

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for the maintenance of roads and/or trails, note that only roads and/or trails that allow "green sticker" off-highway vehicles are allowed to receive grant funding.

Also, applicant must identify why online classes are necessary considering these are already available.• A – Applicant must identify all acronyms by name.• A – Applicant must identify what other outreach materials are going to be distributed.• B – Applicant must identify how this program is going to provide an incentive to do well in school as well as be a positive force in the community. In addition, applicant must explain how that is related to OHV.	

Project Cost Estimate

- Staff – Range Volunteer, Outreach Volunteer, Equipment Operator – Applicant must provide additional details regarding these line items.
- Materials and Supplies – Lumber and building supplies – Applicant must provide additional details for this line item; is this a permanent structure?
- Materials and Supplies - Flip Cam video cameras – This line item is excessive when compared to other projects and is not necessary for the project.
- Materials and Supplies - 1 TB external HD for video data st – This line item has been cut off. Applicant must provide additional details explaining what this item is.
- Equipment Use Expenses Vehicle Operations and Maintenance – RUV to use for ROHVA Training Cour - Applicant cannot claim maintenance on vehicles that have not yet been purchased.
- Others – Insurance – This is an indirect cost.
- Others – Training – This cost appears excessive. Applicant must provide further details.
- Others – Radio Advertising – Applicant must provide additional details.
- Others – Lease of training site - is this an actual training site? This is not clear and not included in section D of the project description. Applicant must provide additional details.

Evaluation Criteria

- #2 – Applicant must verify response.
- #4 – Narrative only supports 2-3 partners. Cahto Tribe - This training site is not identified in section D; training with Campbell Hawthorne employees is not to the general public.
- #6 – Applicant must verify the following:
 - Date(s) of meeting(s) and indicate if stakeholder meeting(s) is different date than publicly noticed meeting(s)
 - How the public/stakeholders meeting(s) were notified and where the meeting(s) were held
 - Names of the stakeholders and how they are stakeholders.
- #7 – Narrative does not support testing of the process or evaluation selections.
- #8 – Narrative and project do not support formal class setting, internet classes or advertising selections. Maintenance classes are not eligible under project. YouTube videos are not eligible online courses.
- #9 – Project does not support response; 100-1,000 selection is appropriate.
- #10 – Project does not support response; the average time is 1-2 hours.
- #11 – Narrative does not support the response. This training does not appear to be available to the public.
