Comments submitted by the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Division to individual grant applicants should in no way be construed as a guarantee of successful results for the applicant within the competitive grants process or a commitment of funding. Additionally, the lack of comments by the OHMVR Division to any specific applicant does not ensure successful results for the applicant within the competitive grant process or a commitment of funding.

All final applications will be reviewed by the OHMVR Division. The OHMVR Division may, at its sole discretion, decrease the requested amount and eliminate activities pursuant with regulation Section 4970.07.2 (f)(1-5) and for law enforcement projects, regulation Section 4970.15.3(b)(1-5).

Failure by applicant to respond to any OHMVR Division comment of their preliminary application shall be cause for eliminating that item from the applicant’s application.

Please note: If multiple proposed projects are requesting funding for the same deliverable, and multiple projects are successful, only one project will receive funding for the deliverable.

**General Evaluation Criteria**

- #9 – Selections made are not appropriate. The applicant does not have an OHV Program.
- #10 – Selections made are not appropriate. The applicant does not have an OHV Program.
- #14 – Applicant must identify the specific BLM office. Also, the narrative does not support “Has created a special fund to set aside funding to sustain OHV Recreation”.

Acquisition

G12-03-71-A01

**Project Description**

- 1A – Project Description indicates that only six of the 11 parcels proposed for acquisition have willing sellers. Applicant must explain why the project should be funded when all parcels may not be for sale. Applicant must also clarify the phases of the project in the project description, e. g. that the first phase would complete CEQA on the proposed parcels and the second phase would be for the land acquisition activities.
- 1C(2) – Narrative indicates that Restoration and Ground Operations activities are part of this project. Applicant is advised that these activities are not appropriate for an Acquisition project.
- 1I – Applicant must provide a breakdown of the cost of each individual parcel and all costs that were used to arrive at the total estimated cost of \$771,000.

### Project Cost Estimate

- Contracts – “Estimated Contract Costs” - See Project Description 11.

### Evaluation Criteria

- #2a, b, c – A reference document must be cited to support the selections made.
- #3 – Narrative does not support the last two selections.
- #4 – Narrative does not support the selection, applicant must identify a stable funding source that directly supports the future development and operation cost.
- #6 – Narrative does not support selections; applicant must provide specific dates of meetings/conference calls and identify all interested parties and stakeholders. In addition these meetings must be separate meetings to qualify.
