Comments submitted by the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Division to individual grant applicants should in no way be construed as a guarantee of successful results for the applicant within the competitive grants process or a commitment of funding. Additionally, the lack of comments by the OHMVR Division to any specific applicant does not ensure successful results for the applicant within the competitive grant process or a commitment of funding.

All final applications will be reviewed by the OHMVR Division. The OHMVR Division may, at its sole discretion, decrease the requested amount and eliminate activities pursuant with regulation Section 4970.07.2 (f)(1-5) and for law enforcement projects, regulation Section 4970.15.3(b)(1-5).

Failure by applicant to respond to any OHMVR Division comment of their preliminary application shall be cause for eliminating that item from the applicant's application.

If multiple proposed projects are requesting funding for the same deliverable, and multiple projects are successful, only one project will receive funding for the deliverable.

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for snow and/or winter activities. Applicants must ensure the activities and/or equipment requested are not and/or cannot be funded by the OHMVR Division Winter Program (commonly referred to as the Snow Grooming Program).

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for the maintenance of roads and/or trails, note that only roads and/or trails that allow "green sticker" off-highway vehicles are allowed to receive grant funding.

Applicants are reminded that no grant funds and/or match can be expended on project activities conducted in any land owned or managed by the California Department of Parks and Recreation.

Applicant must provide additional information explaining the perceived duplication. 	

Evaluation Criteria
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> #4 – Applicant must list each partner organization(s) separately and explain how it and its partners will work together on its proposed project. The Los Angeles County Sheriff’s Department cannot be its own partner. #6 – Narrative does not support the response. Applicant must substantiate how the public meeting was noticed, how public input was solicited, and if the public meeting was initiated and conducted by the Applicant. #7 – Narrative does not support selections; “Objectives”, and “Plan to implement the Project”. Applicant must provide clearly identifiable and/or measurable, elements to substantiate these selections. #8 – Narrative does not support selections; “Social media”, “Outreach booths/Exhibits”, “CDs/DVDs”, or “Audio/video programs”. Applicant must provide additional information explaining how these selections will be utilized for OHV education in the project.
