Comments submitted by the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Division to individual grant applicants should in no way be construed as a guarantee of successful results for the applicant within the competitive grants process or a commitment of funding. Additionally, the lack of comments by the OHMVR Division to any specific applicant does not ensure successful results for the applicant within the competitive grant process or a commitment of funding.

All final applications will be reviewed by the OHMVR Division. The OHMVR Division may, at its sole discretion, decrease the requested amount and eliminate activities pursuant with regulation Section 4970.07.2 (f)(1-5) and for law enforcement projects, regulation Section 4970.15.3(b)(1-5).

Failure by applicant to respond to any OHMVR Division comment of their preliminary application shall be cause for eliminating that item from the applicant's application.

If multiple proposed projects are requesting funding for the same deliverable, and multiple projects are successful, only one project will receive funding for the deliverable.

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for snow and/or winter activities. Applicants must ensure the activities and/or equipment requested are not and/or cannot be funded by the OHMVR Division Winter Program (commonly referred to as the Snow Grooming Program).

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for the maintenance of roads and/or trails, note that only roads and/or trails that allow "green sticker" off-highway vehicles are allowed to receive grant funding.

Applicants are reminded that no grant funds and/or match can be expended on project activities conducted in any land owned or managed by the California Department of Parks and Recreation.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 'A'-Task 1: Video on OHV Opportunities – Applicant must provide additional information supporting how the proposed video production will educate the general OHV community relative to public safety and the environment.</li> <li>• 'A'-Task 3: Informational Kiosk – Applicant must state if it has permission or authority to install informational bulletin board/kiosk on State property.</li> <li>• 'D'-Location of Training Services – It appears that Applicant currently does not have clearance to install the informational bulletin board/kiosk on State property.</li> </ul>	
<b>Project Cost Estimate</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Staff – Administrative Officer – This is an Indirect Cost.</li> <li>• Contracts – Construction – This request appears excessive in comparison to proposed contracts of similar OHV education grants. Applicant must provide additional information substantiating cost for this line item.</li> </ul>	
<b>Evaluation Criteria</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• #5 – Selections are not addressed in the Project Description. Applicant must provide additional information substantiating the selections.</li> <li>• #6 – Narrative does not support the response. Applicant did not publicly notice the meeting and did not explain how the stakeholders they list are actual stakeholders for the project.</li> <li>• #7 – Narrative does not support selections; “Processing of researching issues and audience”, “Testing process to ensure actions are effective”, “Plan to implement the Project”, and “Evaluation and feedback of the process”. Applicant must provide clearly identifiable and/or measurable, elements to substantiate these selections.</li> <li>• #8 – Narrative does not support selection; “Other (specify) [Website, Youtube, not CD's]”. Applicant must substantiate how, “Other (specify) [Website, Youtube, not CD's]”, is being utilized for OHV education in this project.</li> </ul>
