Failure by applicant to respond to any OHMVR Division comment of their preliminary application shall be cause for eliminating that item from the applicant's application.

Please note: If multiple proposed projects are requesting funding for the same deliverable, and multiple projects are successful, only one project will receive funding for the deliverable.

- #8b –The narrative does not support “20 to 49 times per year” It is unclear where the onsite education efforts are taking place.
- #8d – Narrative does not support “At least 30 times per year”. It is unclear if the onsite education efforts are currently taking place or will take place in the future.
- #9 – Applicant must verify response.
- #13 – Narrative does not support “On most (50% more) holidays and weekends.
- #14 – The narrative does not support “Has engaged in collaborative processes with agencies that manage OHV Opportunities”.

Additionally, these meeting(s) must be a separate meeting from the “Publicly noticed meeting(s)”. • #5 – City of Lompoc, as the Land Manager, is not eligible as a partner organization. • #7 – “Barrier materials...”, “Signs, sign posts...”, and “Erosion control features...” are not supported in the Project Description. • #7 – “Wood chips” do not qualify for ‘Other products with recycled content’.
