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**Project Description**

- A – The project description, as written, does not appear to provide the activities or products the project proposes to create or undertake.
- E – Much of the narrative in this item may be more appropriate under item A.

**Project Cost Estimate**

- Staff – Not clear if the “Outreach Coordinator” may be funded through another grant source and if activities of the “Outreach Coordinator” are 100% related to OHV Recreation.
- Staff – “Park Ranger” is identified, however, if this staff is performing enforcement activities, this would not be applicable for this project. Applicant may want to provide details of the activities this staff will perform for this project. Additionally, this staff is listed twice at two different rates. Applicant may want to provide additional detail to clarify.
- Staff – “Administration Officer” may be more appropriate under “Administrative Costs” category.
- Equipment Purchases – Item listed with note appears to be two separate items. Applicant may want to clarify.
- Others – “Training” does not appear to be supported in project description.

**Evaluation Criteria**

- #2 – Item is checked incorrectly. Applicant is “First time..” applicant.
- #5 – Applicant may consider checking the item “M.C.”.
