**Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Commission Meeting and
Tour of Rubicon Trail
September 14-15, 2012**

The public is invited to join the California State Parks Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Commission on Friday, September 14, 2012, for a tour of the historic Rubicon Trail. The tour will provide the Commission, guests, and the public a general overview of this world famous off-highway vehicle (OHV) route.

On Saturday, September 15, 2012, the OHMVR Commission will hold a public meeting at the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors Chambers, 330 Fair Lane, Placerville. The Commission will receive an update on the Grants Program, Twentynine Palms FEIS, and the Rubicon Trail.

The tour will begin at 9:00 a.m. at the Rubicon Trail Loon Lake Kiosk/Traihead. Due to the rough terrain, a high clearance 4WD vehicle capable of crossing the Rubicon Trail is recommended to participate in this tour. Following the tour, the public is encouraged to attend the OHMVR Commission meeting on Saturday, September 15, 2012. The meeting will begin at 9:00 a.m. at the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors Chambers located at 330 Fair Lane, Placerville, CA.

The OHMVR Commission consists of nine members appointed by the Governor, Senate Committee on Rules, and the Speaker of the Assembly. The Commissioners are responsible for hearing the concerns and issues of the public related to off-highway vehicle recreation in California and for providing input and recommendations for improving the California State Parks OHMVR Program.

Obtaining public input is an important purpose of the meeting. The public may present oral statements at the Commission meeting at the appropriate time.
