**NOTICE OF PUBLIC AVAILABILITY OF CHANGES TO
DOCUMENT INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE
15-DAY COMMENT PERIOD**

The Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Division is proposing to revise a document incorporated by reference in the Grants and Cooperative Agreements Program regulations. The OHMVR Division proposes to revise the *Project Agreement General Provisions (U.S. Forest Service Only)(Rev.1/11)*. The U.S. Forest Service has advised the OHMVR Division after the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking was published, that *Section F, Indemnification* in the existing document was problematic and could jeopardize their ability to enter into grants and cooperative agreements with the OHMVR Division. Legal counsel from both parties have concurred that existing law would take precedence and Section F was unnecessary. The revision to the document is presented in strikeout/underline format.

In accordance with Sections 11346.8(c) and 11347.1 of the Government Code, the revised document is available for public review at the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Division, 1725 23rd Street, Suite 200, Sacramento, California from October 22, 2010 through November 5, 2010.
