OHMVR Commission Tour Update

The effects of heavy rains or snow occurring in the Mendocino National Forest can trigger a trail closure for the OHV recreating areas of the forest. Currently the National Weather Service is projecting a 40% to 80% of rain at the higher elevations of the Mendocino National Forest on February 27, 2014. USFS Upper Lake Ranger District has advised a rain fall total of 2 inches or more in the period of 24 hours will trigger a trail closure for the Mendocino National Forest. Trail closures or road closures in the Mendocino National Forest will possibly shorten or cause a cancellation of the OHMVR Commission tour.

The USFS Hydrologist will make a separate appraisal of conditions regarding forest Level 2 roads in the Mendocino National Forest. Level 2 road closures could also lessen or cancel the scheduled Commission Tour. USFS officials do not have the authority to open or close county roads traveling through the Mendocino National Forest.

If weather conditions preclude travel on trails and non-paved roads, the tour may be shortened to include only travel on paved roads. Please dress appropriately for potentially inclement weather.
