Comments submitted by the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Division to individual grant applicants should in no way be construed as a guarantee of successful results for the applicant within the competitive grants process or a commitment of funding. Additionally, the lack of comments by the OHMVR Division to any specific applicant does not ensure successful results for the applicant within the competitive grant process or a commitment of funding.

All final applications will be reviewed by the OHMVR Division. The OHMVR Division may, at its sole discretion, decrease the requested amount and eliminate activities pursuant with regulation Section 4970.07.2 (f)(1-5) and for law enforcement projects, regulation Section 4970.15.3(b)(1-5).

Failure by applicant to respond to any OHMVR Division comment of their preliminary application shall be cause for eliminating that item from the applicant's application.

If multiple proposed projects are requesting funding for the same deliverable, and multiple projects are successful, only one project will receive funding for the deliverable.

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for snow and/or winter activities. Applicants must ensure the activities and/or equipment requested are not and/or cannot be funded by the OHMVR Division Winter Program (commonly referred to as the Snow Grooming Program).

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for the maintenance of roads and/or trails, note that only roads and/or trails that allow "green sticker" off-highway vehicles are allowed to receive grant funding.

Applicants are reminded that no grant funds and/or match can be expended on project activities conducted in any land owned or managed by the California Department of Parks and Recreation.

### General Evaluation Criteria

- #1a – Dates provided do not appear to be most recent.
- #2 – Applicant must verify response.
- #3a&b – Applicant must verify response.
- #4 – Selection appears to be incorrect. Applicant's prior project ended 10/15/14 which was within applicants current fiscal year.
- #7c – Narrative does not support selections.
- #9a – Narrative does not support selection; a systematic methodology for evaluating soil conditions for OHV opportunities does not appear to yet exist.
- #9b – Narrative does not support selection; methods to address soil issues for OHV opportunities does not appear to yet exist.
- #9c – Selection is in conflict with #9a&b.
- #11a – Narrative does not support either selection. It is unclear free literature describing safe and responsible OHV recreation is available to visitors or if the kiosks provide information concerning safe and responsible OHV recreation.
- #11d – Narrative does not support the selection for the providing of ATV Safety

- Institute and/or Motorcycle Safety Foundation approved training courses.
- #12b – Information was not found on applicant’s website to support “Information on responsible riding”, “Hours of operation”, “Visitor facilities”, “Seasonal restrictions” or “Law enforcement contact information” OHV related selections.
- #14 – Applicant answered in error. Only Applicants or Land Managers with NO legal riding opportunities should respond to this question.

- Contracts, Hydrologist and GIS Consultant – Applicant must add details regarding how costs for contracts were determined.
- Equipment Use Expenses, 2015 Volunteer 4x4 Jeep/Trailers – Applicant must provide additional information on how this line item is related to a Planning project.
- Others, User Group Volunteer Effort 2015 – Applicant must provide additional information on this line item.

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| <b>Evaluation Criteria</b> |  |
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- #2b – Narrative does not support “Potential effect of OHV Recreation on adjacent lands” selection and does not provide a detailed explanation.
- #4 – Publicly Noticed Meetings, Meetings with Stakeholders – Narrative does not support either selection, does not indicate the date of a publicly noticed meeting or how the public was notified about the meeting, and does not indicate how the identified stakeholders are actual stakeholders in this project.
- #5 – Narrative does not provide a detailed explanation of how each stakeholder will provide substantial input in this planning project.
- #6 – Narrative does not list each partner organization separately or provide a detailed explanation on how each partner will participate in this planning project.
