Additionally, the lack of comments by the OHMVR Division to any specific applicant does not ensure successful results for the applicant within the competitive grant process or a commitment of funding.

All final applications will be reviewed by the OHMVR Division. The OHMVR Division may, at its sole discretion, decrease the requested amount and eliminate activities pursuant with regulation Section 4970.07.2 (f)(1-5) and for law enforcement projects, regulation Section 4970.15.3(b)(1-5).

Failure by applicant to respond to any OHMVR Division comment of their preliminary application shall be cause for eliminating that item from the applicant's application.

If multiple proposed projects are requesting funding for the same deliverable, and multiple projects are successful, only one project will receive funding for the deliverable.

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for snow and/or winter activities. Applicants must ensure the activities and/or equipment requested are not and/or cannot be funded by the OHMVR Division Winter Program (commonly referred to as the Snow Grooming Program).

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for the maintenance of roads and/or trails, note that only roads and/or trails that allow "green sticker" off-highway vehicles are allowed to receive grant funding.

Applicants are reminded that no grant funds and/or match can be expended or project activities conducted in any land owned or managed by the California Department of Parks and Recreation.

- #8b – Applicant must provide the name and date of the reference document.
- #12a&b - Applicant must verify responses.
- #13 – Applicant must verify that selections are actions taken by the applicant and not the Land Manager.

Applicant must adjust Project Description and Cost Estimate accordingly. • A – Outdoor OHV workshops including rider safety, trail etiquette and Tread Lightly techniques are Education activities and are not eligible in a Ground Operations grant. Applicant must adjust Project Description and Cost Estimate accordingly.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicant must adjust Cost Estimate to remove any items related to Restoration or Education activities. • Staff – Plumas County, project coordinator – The duties listed are indirect costs. • Staff – Plumas Forest, agreement – The duties listed are indirect costs. • Contracts – Trail Maintenance Contract – The per mile rate appears excessive in comparison to other projects. Applicant must provide additional details regarding how the rate was determined. • Equipment Purchases – Polaris ATV (2) & cart & Polaris side by side – The information in the Project Description regarding these purchases is different than what is listed in the notes of the Cost Estimate. Applicant must clarify the uses for the equipment that is requested.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • #2 – Narrative does not support “Additional damage to Facilities” selection. • #3 – Project Description does not support “Providing traffic control...” or “Providing varied levels...” selections. • #4 – Applicant must identify how the participants are stakeholders to the project. • #5 – Sierra Buttes Trail Stewardship is a paid participant in this project and is therefore not an eligible partner. • #6 – The selection of “Site design precludes...” is incorrect. This selection is intended for a full fenced facility only. • #7 – Project Description does not support “Signs, sign posts...” selection. In addition, the “Other products with recycled...” selection is duplicative. • #8 – Snowmobiling is a motorized recreation opportunity.
