Additionally, the lack of comments by the OHMVR Division to any specific applicant does not ensure successful results for the applicant within the competitive grant process or a commitment of funding.

All final applications will be reviewed by the OHMVR Division. The OHMVR Division may, at its sole discretion, decrease the requested amount and eliminate activities pursuant with regulation Section 4970.07.2 (f)(1-5) and for law enforcement projects, regulation Section 4970.15.3(b)(1-5).

Failure by applicant to respond to any OHMVR Division comment of their preliminary application shall be cause for eliminating that item from the applicant's application.

If multiple proposed projects are requesting funding for the same deliverable, and multiple projects are successful, only one project will receive funding for the deliverable.

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for snow and/or winter activities. Applicants must ensure the activities and/or equipment requested are not and/or cannot be funded by the OHMVR Division Winter Program (commonly referred to as the Snow Grooming Program).

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for the maintenance of roads and/or trails, note that only roads and/or trails that allow "green sticker" off-highway vehicles are allowed to receive grant funding.

Applicants are reminded that no grant funds and/or match can be expended or project activities conducted in any land owned or managed by the California Department of Parks and Recreation.

- #13 – Applicant must verify that selections are actions taken by the applicant and not the Land Manager.

OHV tracks do not improve or create new trails and do not provide motorized access to non-motorized trails. • #10 – Publicly Noticed Meetings, Meetings with Stakeholders – Narrative does not support either response, does not indicate how the public was notified or indicate how the stakeholders listed are actual stakeholders in this project. Public meeting does not appear to be hosted by the applicant. • #13 – Narrative does not address how sound, fugitive dust, or runoff will be addressed. Applicant must provide additional detail.

Applicant must provide additional detailed information substantiating these selections. • #6 – Narrative does not support the response. Applicant must provide additional information showing how the public meeting was noticed and how listed stakeholders are actual stakeholders for this project. • #8 – Narrative does not support selection; “Formal class setting”. Applicant must provide additional information explaining how this selection will be utilized for OHV education in the project.
