Comments submitted by the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Division to individual grant applicants should in no way be construed as a guarantee of successful results for the applicant within the competitive grants process or a commitment of funding. Additionally, the lack of comments by the OHMVR Division to any specific applicant does not ensure successful results for the applicant within the competitive grant process or a commitment of funding.

All final applications will be reviewed by the OHMVR Division. The OHMVR Division may, at its sole discretion, decrease the requested amount and eliminate activities pursuant with regulation Section 4970.07.2 (f)(1-5) and for law enforcement projects, regulation Section 4970.15.3(b)(1-5).

Failure by applicant to respond to any OHMVR Division comment of their preliminary application shall be cause for eliminating that item from the applicant's application.

If multiple proposed projects are requesting funding for the same deliverable, and multiple projects are successful, only one project will receive funding for the deliverable.

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for snow and/or winter activities. Applicants must ensure the activities and/or equipment requested are not and/or cannot be funded by the OHMVR Division Winter Program (commonly referred to as the Snow Grooming Program).

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for the maintenance of roads and/or trails, note that only roads and/or trails that allow "green sticker" off-highway vehicles are allowed to receive grant funding.

Applicants are reminded that no grant funds and/or match can be expended or project activities conducted in any land owned or managed by the California Department of Parks and Recreation.

General Evaluation Criteria

- #3b – It is unclear if there is opportunity for 3 or more vehicle types. Applicant's website conflicts with this selection.
- #4 – Based on the narrative, more than 50% of the program was funded with OHV Trust Funds.
- #5 – Applicant must verify response.

Project Cost Estimate

- Contracts – Operations and Maintenance- Applicant must add notes to explain what this is comprised of and how the cost was determined.
- Contracts – Alarm Monitoring is an Indirect Cost.
- Equipment Use Expenses- Fuel/Oil, Repair Services- Applicant must provide details on each line item and explain how cost was determined.
- Others – Utilities- Applicant must provide details on line item and explain how cost was determined.
- Others – Insurance- Applicant must provide details on line item and explain how cost was determined. Insurance is an Indirect Cost.

Evaluation Criteria

- #2 – Narrative and Project Description does not support the selections.
- #3 – Narrative and Project Description does not support the last three selections.
- #4 – Narrative does not support the selection. Applicant must explain how the public was engaged in the development of this application and where the meeting was held.
- #5 – Narrative does not support the selection. Applicant must list each partner organization separately and provide a detailed explanation for how each partner will participate in the project.
- #7 – Project Description does not support any of the selections.
- #8 – Project Description does not support any of the selections.
