Discussion

2014 OHMVR Commission Triennial Program Report (2014 Report)

Public Resource Code (PRC) Section 5090.24(h) requires the OHMVR Commission to prepare and submit a triennial program report for California's OHMVR program to the Governor; the Assembly Water, Parks, and Wildlife Committee; the Senate Committee on Natural Resources and Water; and the Committee on Appropriations of each house. The 2014 Report is due on or before January 1, 2014. The 2014 Report shall be

adopted by the OHMVR Commission after discussing the contents at two or more OHMVR Commission meetings.

The PRC identifies certain required elements to be included in the triennial report:

- Strategic Plan accomplishments
- Condition of natural and cultural resources relative to areas and trails funded by the OHV Trust Fund
- Conflict resolution relative to areas and trails funded by the OHV Trust Fund
- Status and accomplishments of the OHMVR Division Grants Program – Restoration
- Summary of OHMVR Division resource monitoring
- Summary of completed OHMVR Division restoration projects
- Actions taken by the OHMVR Division to reduce OHV trespass
- Other items of interest
