Comments submitted by the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Division to individual grant applicants should in no way be construed as a guarantee of successful results for the applicant within the competitive grants process or a commitment of funding. Additionally, the lack of comments by the OHMVR Division to any specific applicant does not ensure successful results for the applicant within the competitive grant process or a commitment of funding.

All final applications will be reviewed by the OHMVR Division. The OHMVR Division may, at its sole discretion, decrease the requested amount and eliminate activities pursuant with regulation Section 4970.07.2 (f)(1-5) and for law enforcement projects, regulation Section 4970.15.3(b)(1-5).

Failure by applicant to respond to any OHMVR Division comment of their preliminary application shall be cause for eliminating that item from the applicant's application.

If multiple proposed projects are requesting funding for the same deliverable, and multiple projects are successful, only one project will receive funding for the deliverable.

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for snow and/or winter activities. Applicants must ensure the activities and/or equipment requested are not and/or cannot be funded by the OHMVR Division Winter Program (commonly referred to as the Snow Grooming Program).

For proposed projects requesting grant funding for the maintenance of roads and/or trails, note that only roads and/or trails that allow "green sticker" off-highway vehicles are allowed to receive grant funding.

Applicants are reminded that no grant funds and/or match can be expended on project activities conducted in any land owned or managed by the California Department of Parks and Recreation.

General Evaluation Criteria

- #2 – Land Manager's MVUM does not support the 3rd selection. Applicant must verify response.
- #3a&b – Applicant must verify response.
- #4 – Information provided does not match the response by the Land Manager. Applicant must verify response and provide the cost of Land Manager's OHV Program based on the most recent complete fiscal year.
- #5 – Applicant must verify response.
- #7b – Information provided does not match the response by the Land Manager. Applicant must verify.
- #11b – Information provided does not match the response by the Land Manager. Applicant must verify.
- #11c – Information provided does not match the response by the Land Manager. Applicant must verify.
- #11d – Narrative does not support ASI or Motorcycle Safety Foundation training is provided to the public "4-7 times per year" and does not match the response by

the Land Manager. Additionally, the training provided solely to volunteers is not eligible to receive points. Training must be provided to the general public.

- #12a&b– Applicant must verify responses.
- #13 – This question is to address the Applicant's OHV outreach efforts, not the Land Manager's efforts. Applicant must verify response.
- #14 – Applicant answered in error. Only Applicants or Land Managers with NO legal riding opportunities should respond to this question.

Project Cost Estimate

- Contracts, all line items – Applicant must provide addition details on which entity is providing match, separate out match as separate volunteer staff line items and consolidate each contractor into two line items for the value of each contract.
- Contracts, Crew Leader – Applicant must provide additional detail on how this position is related to a planning project.
- Equipment Use Expense, all line items – Applicant must separate out match as separate volunteer vehicle line items and consolidate each contractors vehicle use cost into the two Contract category line items as part of the value for each contract.
- Others, Printing – Applicant must consolidate contractor printing cost into the Contract category line item as part of the value of the contract.

Evaluation Criteria

- #2b – Narrative does not support any selections and does not provide a detailed explanation for each statement checked.
- #3 – Project description does not support selections.
- #4 – Meetings with Stakeholders – Narrative does not indicate how the identified stakeholders are actual stakeholders in this Planning project.
- #5 – Narrative does not identify stakeholders or provide a detailed explanation of how each stakeholder will provide substantial input in this planning project.
- #6 – Narrative does not support the selection. Identified partner organization is a paid participant in this project.
- #7 – Narrative does not support “project supports development of OHV Opportunities in areas that lack legal OHV Opportunity” selection.
