- #2 – Map with OHV recreational opportunities was not found on the Land Manager’s website. Selection #5 was added since the previous grant application.
- #5 – Selection is not supported by Division records.
- #7c – Narrative does not support selections.
- #8d – Narrative does not support the selection.
- #9 – Selections do not support information found on the Land Manager’s website as referenced.

- B – Narrative does not explain how OHV’s caused the damage.
- F – Narrative is not required unless the project involves scientific and cultural studies.

Project Cost Estimate

- #1 – Staff- “Project Coordinator II” does not appear to be a direct cost related to the project.
- #1 – Staff- GIS Manager; applicant may want to provide additional information.
- #5 - Other (Truck) – Applicant may want to provide more detail with regard to the purchase.
- #6 – Others- Line items appear to be indirect costs. Applicant may want to revise.
- Indirect Costs – Total Indirect Costs exceed 15% of the Grant Request amount. Applicant may want to adjust.

Evaluation Criteria

- #2 – Narrative does not support selections.
- #7 - Narrative does not support selections.
- #8 – Applicant cannot list themselves as a partner. It is unclear how listed partners will be utilized in the scope of this project. Applicant may want to provide additional information and revise.
- #9 – Project does not appear to include scientific and cultural studies.
- #10 – Narrative does not support response.
- #11 – Applicant may want to verify that the response is relative to the size of sensitive habitats which will be restored for this project.
