- A – Applicant may want to explain more clearly what activities will be conducted for this project. Restoration activities such as route closures and rehabilitation are not appropriate under a Ground Operations project.

Project Cost Estimate

- #1 – Staff "Other – Patrol Staff" is unclear. Applicant may want to provide additional information to ensure this is not Law Enforcement activity.
- #1 – Staff "Other – District Recreation Officer" and "Other – District Resource Officer" appear to be indirect costs.
- #2 – Contracts – "Other – FOTHL Liability Insurance" and "Other – FOTHL Operating Plan" are unclear.

Evaluation Criteria

- #2 - Narrative does not support response with regard to "Cultural Sites".
- #4 - Narrative does not support response with regard to "Conference Calls", or provide dates of public input.
- #5 - Narrative does not support response. There appears to be one partner on multiple projects.
- #6 - Narrative does not support response with regard to "protecting cultural sites".

- #7 – Narrative does not support response. Maps do not appear to be part of the project.
- #8 – Narrative does not support response.
