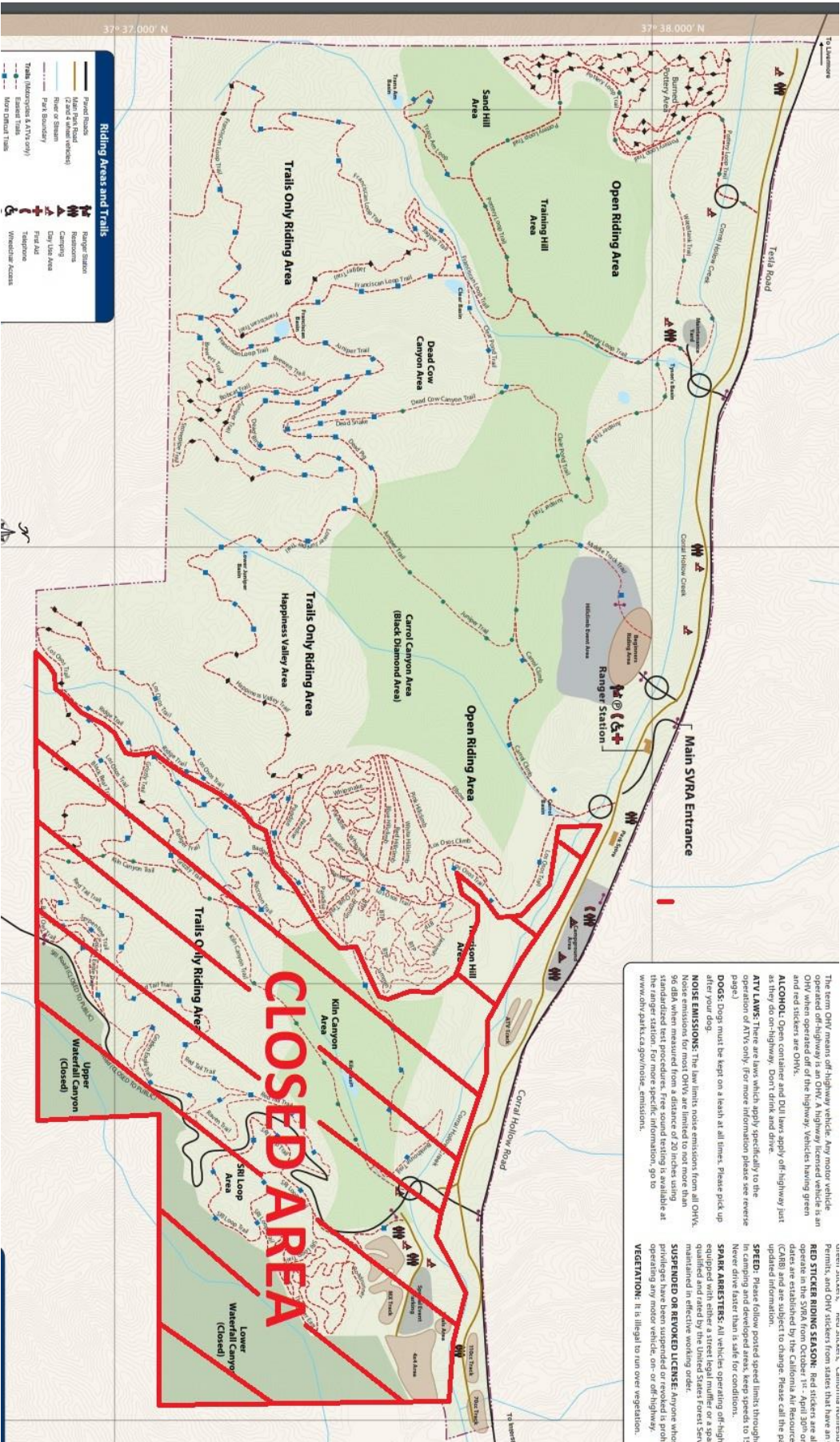

The term **OHV** means off-highway vehicle. Any motor vehicle, including but not limited to, ATVs, mopeds, snowblowers, and snowblowers, is an OHV when operated off of the highway. Vehicles having green and red stickers are OHVs.

ALCOHOL: Open container and DUI laws apply off-highway just as they do on-highway. Don't drink and drive.

ATV LAWS: There are laws which apply specifically to the operation of ATVs only. For more information please see reverse page.)

DOGS: Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. Please pick up after your dog.

NOISE EMISSIONS: The law limits noise emissions from all OHVs. Noise emissions for most OHVs are limited to not more than 96 dba when measured from a distance of 20 inches using the ringer station. For more specific information go to www.dhv.parks.ca.gov/noise_emissions.

PERMITS, AND OHV STICKERS: CARPORTING PERMITS, AND OHV STICKERS FROM STATES THAT HAVE AN **OHV** sticker from states that have an **OHV** sticker are all valid until October 31st. After that date (CAB) and are subject to change. Please call the park for updated information.

SPEED: Please follow posted speed limits, through in camping and developed areas, keep speeds to 15 mph or less. Never drive faster than is safe for conditions.

SPARK ARRESTERS: All vehicles operating off-highway equipped with either a street legal muffler or a spark arrester must be maintained in effective working order.

SUSPENDED OR REVOKED LICENSE: Anyone who is operating any motor vehicle on- or off-highway with a suspended or revoked license is in violation of state law. It is illegal to run over vegetation.
