



Hollister Hills SVRA  
Posted Order- Juvenile Curfew

1. Under the authority of the State of California Public Resources Code Section 5003 and California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 4317, a curfew for Juveniles is in effect for Hollister Hills State Vehicular Recreation Area.
2. The hours of this curfew shall be 10:00pm to 6:00am. The period of this curfew shall be indefinite.
3. Exceptions to this curfew order are encumbered in California Code of Regulations Section 4317(c).
4. Nothing herein shall affect any existing private, contractual and residential or property rights.
5. Nothing herein shall be construed to be in derogation of other provisions of the law.
