2-3:30 p.m. Jr. Off-Highway Ranger

Location: District Office

Campfire/Night Program Transportation FAQ's

Can I ride after sunset?

Riding off-road after sunset is prohibited, unless a California State Park sponsored special event exemption, is provided by the Hollister Hills District Superintendent.

What is required to ride/drive to and from a special event exemption?

During such an event, all vehicles must meet the operating requirements of the California Vehicle Code, including but not limited to required vehicle lighting during darkness.

Can I get a DUI while riding off-road?

Yes, you can be arrested for Driving Under the Influence while driving off-road. All the same fines and penalties apply.
