Campfire/Night Program Transportation FAQ's

Can I ride after sunset?

Yes, but only to a CA State Park sponsored evening program and back to your campsite. This is per the exemption provided by the Hollister Hills District Superintendent.

What is required to ride/drive to and from a special event exemption?

All vehicle must have front and rear lights and meet other requirements per the California Vehicle Code,

Can I get a DUI while riding off-road?

Yes, you can be arrested for Driving Under the Influence while driving off-road. All the same fines and penalties apply.
