**Project Description:**

The CDPR, OHMVR Division proposes to implement a dust control program at Pismo State Beach and Oceano Dunes SVRA. The project involves: 1) Planting approx. 20 acres of native vegetation per year at Oceano Dunes SVRA (trees may also be planted downwind of the SVRA); 2) Deploying approx. 40 acres of temporary wind fencing and/or other dust control measures per year at Oceano Dunes SVRA; 3) Potentially applying non-toxic soil stabilizers at Oceano Dunes SVRA; 4) Preventing track-out of sand onto Grand Avenue in the City of Grover Beach and Pier Avenue in Oceano; and 5) Dust and meteorological monitoring at Oceano Dunes SVRA.
