TITLE: Donkey Caretaker (Park Aide)

SALARY: \$9.98/hr. (up to 1500 hrs/year)

As a Donkey Caretaker park aide, you would provide the care necessary to keep the two Old Town San Diego State Historic Park donkeys healthy and happy. Spend time interacting with other people and animals while grooming, bathing and exercising donkeys. Help with the upkeep of the stables and implement the composting program. Also you would interact with the public to educate them on the park's history and the role of donkeys in the Old Town historic community.

Key Responsibilities:

1. Grooming and bathing donkeys
2. Cleaning stalls and areas occupied by donkeys
3. Exercising and turning out donkeys
4. Leading donkeys during interpretive/educational programs

Time Requirements:

Approximately 32 hours per week, 4-5 days per week
Hours flexible

Skills/Qualifications:

Experience working with horses or donkeys. Should be reliable, patient, have a positive attitude and a willingness to learn. Should have an interest in history, living history desirable, but not required.
