Angel Island State Park's Ayala Cove Road Scheduled for Repaving in September

TIBURON, CA: From Monday, September 10 to Friday, September 16, sections of roadway leading from Ayala Cove to the Perimeter Road will be repaved. During this period, visitors can expect to see road-work activity, hear construction equipment, and smell resurfacing materials.

There will be a total road closure along Ayala Cove Road from the Cove Café area to the junction with the Perimeter Road loop September 13, continuing to September 15, at which time there will be no Tram tours and Segway tours. However bicycle and pedestrian lanes will remain open.

The road-work is expected to be complete on Friday, September 16. In case of rain or heavy fog, construction dates may change. For specific questions about visiting Angel Island when the road-work takes place please call 415-435-5390.
