DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

This project consists of the filling in of two open dirt areas on the Old Town San Diego State Historic Park's Plaza walkway. This area is located on the north side of the Plaza next to the lawn west 25' of Bara Bara Restaurant and 15' across the walkway from El Fandango Restaurant. The dirt will be excavated approximately 6" in depth and 8' in length, and 4' in width. The existing site is clay soil in the concrete opening. Previous development was concrete which will be reinstated to conform to existing walkway and avoid potential for tripping hazard.
