**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:**

Issue a Right of Entry (ROE) to Suddenlink Cable to enter Sugar Pine Point State Park to replace the Suddenlink Communications cable. The ROE will be valid through October 15, 2010 and this Notice of Exemption (NOE) supersedes an NOE filed for issuance of the ROE on September 24, 2009 (SCH # 2009098250).

Suddenlink Cable will be responsible for complying with all State and Federal environmental laws, including but not limited to the Endangered Species Act, California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), and Section 5024 of the Public Resources Code related to actual project activities. DPR will be advised if any new historical resources (including archaeological sites), special status species, Threatened/Endangered Species, or other resource issues are identified within the area.
