
PROJECT LOCATION: San Elijo State Beach, San Diego County, CA

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: This project replaces and enhances an existing lifeguard headquarters located on a bluff at the southern end of San Elijo State Beach. The bluff on the beach side of the lifeguard headquarters has been eroding to the point where it is jeopardizing the building's structural stability. The larger replacement facility will be built behind the bluff and to current codes and standards. It will also provide a public contact and first-aid facility. The observation tower will extend over the bluff to provide visual monitoring of the ocean.

The California Department of Parks and Recreation has approved this project on December 28, 2006 and has made the following determinations:

- 1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
 The project will have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2. A Final Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted, pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
 A Final Environmental Impact Report has been completed in compliance with CEQA, and has been presented to the decision-making body of this Department for its independent review and consideration of the information, prior to approval of the project.
- 3. Mitigation measures were were not made conditions of project approval.
- 4. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for this project.
- 5. Findings were were not made on environmental effects of the project.
