

**TITLE 14. NATURAL RESOURCES
GRANTS AND COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS PROGRAM REGULATIONS**

**NOTICE OF MODIFICATION TO TEXT OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS AND
ADDING DOCUMENTS TO RULEMAKING FILE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN the California Department of Parks and Recreation (Department), pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(c) and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, proposes modifications to the California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Division 3, Chapter 15, Article 1 (CCR), Section 4970.06.3 and the 2020 Soil Conservation Standard and Guidelines (incorporated by reference) pertaining to the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Division (OHMVR Division) Grants and Cooperative Agreements Program.

This regulatory proposal was the subject of a 45-day comment period from June 25, 2021, through August 9, 2021. No regulatory hearing was held.

Note that the following document incorporated by reference is also being modified with this 15-day notice:

- 2020 Soil Conservation Standard and Guidelines

Notice is also given that an Addendum to the Initial Statement of Reasons (Addendum) and additional documents relied upon are added to the rulemaking file pursuant to Government Code section 11347.1.

The Addendum supplements the information and necessity rationale for the originally proposed regulations that were omitted or incorrectly addressed in the Initial Statement of Reasons.
