Need Assessment

- Item #2 – Applicant must provide additional detail showing the OHV nexus and the number of miles, acreage or square miles being patrolled. Additionally, Applicant is reminded all OHV enforcement activities must have an OHV Recreation nexus. Applicant must revise to remove all activities related to regular patrol.
- Item #3 – Applicant must provide additional details on the type of OHV vehicles being used. Additionally, Applicant is reminded that using a Dual Sport motorcycle for patrol on roadways is not an eligible activity under the OHMVR Law Enforcement Grant. Applicant must revise Item 3 to remove as well as any costs associated with patrol on roadways.

Needs Enforcement Certification

- #6 – Applicant must provide additional details identifying curriculum used to train personnel in natural and cultural resource protection.

Project Cost Estimate

- Indirect Costs #1 “WeBoost portable antenna system” – Applicant is advised upgrades for vehicles not being requested in this application are not an eligible expense under an OHV Law Enforcement Grant.
- Indirect Costs #3 “OHV Motorcycle Recovery Equipment” – Applicant must better describe what this item entails.
