- Staff #2 "OHV Deputy Overtime Patrol" Job duties are unclear. Applicant must revise line item to identify OHV patrol duties directly related to the scope of the Project.
- Staff #3 "OHV Deputy Patrol Regular Hours" Job duties are unclear. Applicant
  must revise line item to identify OHV patrol duties directly related to the scope of
  the Project.

- Others #1 "0225 Husqvarna Dual Sport Dirt Bike" Applicant will move this request into the Equipment category of the Project Cost Estimate.
- Indirect Costs #1 "ATV Tires" Quantity is excessive. Applicant must declare if the supported equipment was purchased with Grant or non-Grant funds and what percentage of the time it will be used for the proposed Project.
- Indirect Costs #2 "ATV storage bags" Quantity is excessive. Applicant must declare if the supported Equipment was purchased with Grant or non-Grant funds and what percentage of the time it will be used for the proposed Project.
