

# **2025 (G25) Grants and Cooperative Agreements Program Nevada County Sheriff's Office's Preliminary Application Comments**

Failure by the Applicant to respond to any OHMVR Division comment of their preliminary Application may be cause for eliminating that item from the Applicant's final Application.

All final Applications will be reviewed by the OHMVR Division. The OHMVR Division may, at its sole discretion, decrease the requested amount and eliminate activities pursuant with regulation Section 4970.07.2 (f)(1-5) and for Law Enforcement Projects, regulation Section 4970.15.3(b)(1-5).

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## **Law Enforcement: G25-03-16-L01**

### **Need Assessment**

- Item #2 – Applicant is reminded that activities such as privately sponsored OHV events are not eligible for funding. Applicant must confirm special events are open to the public.

### **Needs Enforcement Certification**

- #1 & 2 – Applicant must clarify if the private lands described are open and accessible to the public. Applicant is reminded that routine OHV patrol deployments must prioritize legal OHV Opportunity areas in order to directly support OHV Recreation.
- #3 – Applicant is reminded that conducting OHV Law Enforcement activities on any land owned or managed by the California Department of Parks and Recreation is not eligible. Applicant must confirm OHV Grant and/or match funds will not be used to patrol State Park lands or outside agency jurisdiction without written permission from the Land Manager.

## **Project Cost Estimate**

- Materials / Supplies #5 “Gear bag/backpack” – Line item is considered indirect as it does not directly relate to the completion of the Project. Applicant must move this line item to the Indirect Costs category.
- Equipment Use Expenses #1-3 – Applicant has stated the pieces of Equipment are County owned. Applicant must revise to use the County rate and not a rental rate from an outside company. Use rate may never exceed the Grantee’s actual cost.
