- #1 – Applicant must clarify if “30 miles of highly eroded GS roads” are open to off-highway vehicles. If not, the deliverable and any associated Project costs with the deliverable must be removed.

Project Description – All Others

Project Cost Estimate

- Contracts #1 “Green Sticker Road Maintenance” – Applicant’s notes for specified road maintenance routes are inconsistent with Project Description. Applicant must clarify the routes to ensure consistency within the Application and correlating expenses in the line item.
- Equipment Use Expenses #4 “ATV/UTV/MC Maintenance & Repair” – Applicant must provide the number of Equipment pieces being maintained and how the maintenance/repair costs were determined.
- Others #1 “Trailer Maintenance & Repair” – Applicant lists “5 OHV trailers purchased with grant funds” needing annual upkeep; however, Applicant’s listing of Equipment inventory on their General Application does not include five (5) OHV-purchased Trailers still in use. Applicant must clarify the number of OHV-purchased Trailers in its inventory still in use and adjust the line item costs accordingly.
