

# 2026 (G26) Grants and Cooperative Agreements Program Plumas County Public Works's Preliminary Application Comments

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Comments submitted by the Department of Parks and Recreation (Department) Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation (OHMVR) Division to individual Grant Applicants should in no way be construed as a guarantee of successful results for the Applicant within the competitive Grants process or a commitment of funding. Additionally, the lack of comments by the OHMVR Division to any specific Applicant does not ensure successful results for the Applicant within the competitive Grant process or a commitment of funding.

Failure by the Applicant to respond to any OHMVR Division comment of their preliminary Application may be cause for eliminating that item from the Applicant's final Application.

All final Applications will be reviewed by the OHMVR Division. The OHMVR Division may, at its sole discretion, decrease the requested amount and eliminate activities pursuant with regulation Section 4970.07.2 (f)(1-5) and for Law Enforcement Projects, regulation Section 4970.15.3(b)(1-5).

If multiple proposed Projects are requesting funding for the same deliverable, and multiple projects are successful, only one project will receive funding for the deliverable.

For proposed Projects requesting Grant funding for snow and/or winter activities. Applicants must ensure the activities and/or Equipment/Heavy Equipment/Trailer requested are not and/or cannot be funded by the Department's Winter Program (commonly referred to as the Snow Grooming Program).

For proposed Projects requesting Grant funding for the maintenance of roads and/or trails, note that only roads and/or trails that allow "green sticker" Off-Highway Vehicles are allowed to receive Grant funding.

Applicants are reminded that no Grant funds and/or match can be expended, or Project activities conducted in any land owned or managed by the Department except as allowed in the Grants and Cooperative Agreements Program regulations section 4970.09 (b)(11).

### **Project Description – List of Project Deliverables**

- #1 – Applicant must clarify the total number of miles of OHV roads that will receive maintenance under this Project and identify the specific locations where the maintenance activities will be performed. In addition, Applicant is reminded that monitoring is not an eligible activity under Project Deliverable #1 but should be included under Project Deliverable #7 or Project Deliverable – Other
- #2 – Applicant must clarify how frequently the Four Corners OHV Track will be maintained. In addition, Applicant is reminded that monitoring is not an eligible activity under Project Deliverable #2 but should be included under Project Deliverable #7 or Project Deliverable – Other.

### **Project Description – All Others**

### **Project Cost Estimate**

- Staff #2 & 3 – Applicant must provide a more detailed description of the activities to be performed under these line items. In addition, the percentage of staff time dedicated to Project Deliverables #1 and 2 is unclear. Applicant must clarify within the line item notes what portion of staff time will be specifically dedicated to the maintenance of OHV trails, roads, and tracks.
- Equipment Use Expenses 2-5 – The proposed hourly rate for this line item has increased significantly compared to the prior year Applications. Applicant must provide a detailed explanation justifying the increase and demonstrate that the proposed rate is reasonable and reflective of the Applicant's actual costs. \*\* The costs went up, but I don't think we have enough grounds to comment based on the line item notes.
- Indirect Costs #1 “Administrative Overhead” – Applicant must provide a clear explanation of how the cost was determined, including the precise scope and amount of work to be conducted. For any Staff positions included in this line item, Applicant must utilize the hourly rate and quantity of hours as the unit of measure to clearly demonstrate how the associated costs were calculated. If helpful, Applicant may break this line item out into multiple Indirect Cost line items to clearly identify and separate the various costs.
