Title: REQUEST FOR PERFORMANCE DATA

BACKGROUND: There are some Agencies who historically underperform. Specifically, the USFS - Usually by unavailable staff. As an example, if they are not able to hire staff to perform OHV activities during a specific Allocated Grant Period those Award funds are lost. In a year of tight budgets, this is effectively denying funds being allocated to another deserving Agency.

Furthermore, implementation of this request will publicly identify any "unused" OHV Grant funds from a prior years that should and could be applied/reallocated to offset that Agency's current OHV Grant Requests.

ISSUE: The CA OHV GRANTS Website does not contain information as to how each Grantee Agency has performed on previously Allocated/Approved OHV Grants.

The OHV Grant Website only has available the past Allocated Grants but not the performance status of those previously approved OHV Grants.

This information currently is only available by submitting a formal "Public Records Request".

Unused Allocated Grant funds from prior years should be identified and applied to offset that Agency's current OHV Grant Requests.

REQUEST: It is requested that the OHV Commission Instruct the OHV Grants Staff to prepare and publish, on the Grants Website, the Project Performance (percent complete, funds used, estimated completion, funds returned, etc.) for each Agency's prior Allocated/Approved Grants.

BENEFIT: Not only will this add a layer of transparency it will also inform the Public as how each Agency is performing. Additionally, it will help each Grant Administrator manage their assigned Agency. This information will be beneficial to the Public during their review and comments for that Agency's future Grant Requests.
